

Aid directory serves remote KZN

NATIONAL data collection agency info4africa released its KwaZulu-Natal Series 7 Support Services Directory 2014 last week. The agency is a self-funded centre in the School of Applied Human Sciences of the humanities department at UKZN, specialising in health, well-being and development.

The directory contains detailed information on 2 300 organisations in the province involved in these fields.

Debbie Heustice, info4africa director, said: "People often need support in remote areas in

KZN, but are not aware what is available to them. Our directory helps solve this problem as it contains a detailed list of organisations providing services and support to vulnerable groups in all areas of the province."

Established in 2001, info4africa used to be known as the Centre for HIV/Aids Networking.
