

'Roux is trying to sow doubt in court'

DR JACKIE de Wet, forensic criminologist and forensic psychologist at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, said Roux's cross-examination of Barend van Staden had been an

attempt to establish time lines which he would then contrast against other evidence at a later stage. He said this type of meticulous testimony was about further establishing doubt in

the mind of the court as to the State's evidence. "They want to show that the evidence doesn't point to an intentional, but an accidental killing," he said.
